

TOWN ORDINANCE No. 76-1
Town of Silver Lake, Ind

TITLE: Ordinance to Control Obstruction of Streets, Alleys,
Sidewalks, Tree Lawns and Public Places.

- SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful to obstruct any street, alley sidewalk or other public place, so as to impede the free use of the same for its proper purposes.
- SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful to park a motor-vehicle or any other object so as to obstruct any street, alley, sidewalk or any other public place, as indicated in Section 1 of this Ordinance.
- SECTION 3: It shall be unlawful to park upon any portion of the public property known as the tree lawn unnecessarily. The tree lawn being the area between the sidewalk and the street.
- SECTION 4: It shall be unlawfull to park a motor vehicle so as to obstruct or block the entrance/exits of the building known as the Fire Department/Station so as to prevent the entrance or exit of any Fire fighting equipment.
- SECTION:5: The penalty for violation of any of the sections of this Ordinance shall be the following:
- a. The violator shall be notified either verbally or in writting to correct the matter, except for any violation of Section 4 of this Ordinance.
 - b. After a period of two (2) hours if the vehicle has not been moved the vehicle shall be towed upon the direction of the Town Marshal, all costs for said towing to be the responsibility of the owner.
 - c. Any violation of Section 4 of this Ordinance shall result in the immediate towing away any vehicle in violation of Sec. 4. by direction of either the Town Marshal or Fire Chief. All costs of the towing being the responsibility of the owner.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. This Ordinance supercedes Ordinance 68-7.
