

ORDINANCE 91-10

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE METHOD FOR DETERMINATION OF CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICE OF THE SEWER SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF SILVER LAKE, KOSCIUSKO COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL MEMEBERS OF THE TOWN OF SILVER LAKE, KOSCIUSKO COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA, as follows:

Section 1. In order that the users of the municipal sewer system of the Town of Silver Lake, Kosciusko County, State of Indiana should not be penalized for the sprinkling of lawns and or gardens during the months of June, July and August, the billing for sewer service for the users for said months of June, July and August shall be based on the metered water usage for the average of six months of use for the months of October, November, December, January, February and March immediately preceding. If the average water usage for the said six months is greater than the metered water usage for the months of June, July and August, then the billing for sewer services shall be computed on the actual water used for which the sewer bill is being rendered.

Section 2. The Ordinance modifying the method for determination of charges for the use and service of the sewer system of the Town of Silver Lake, Kosciusko County, State of Indiana rates shall go into effect as of January 1, 1992.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law and shall supersede any previous Ordinance.
