

ORDINANCE #89-7
TITLE: ABANDONED VEHICLES

ORDINANCE REGULATING ABANDONED VEHICLES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SILVER LAKE,
KOSCIUSKO COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA

Be it ordained by the Town Council Members of the Town of Silver Lake, Kosciusko County, State of Indiana that this is an amendment to Ordinance 83-2 and that it shall be unlawful to leave, park, or abandon any type of vehicle within the confines of the Town of Silver Lake, Kosciusko County, State of Indiana. Any violation of this Ordinance shall result in the said vehicle being removed at the owners expense.

SECTION ONE: "ABANDONED VEHICLE" MEANS:

1. a vehicle located on public property illegally;
2. a vehicle left on public property continuously without being moved for three (3) days;
3. a vehicle located on public property in such a manner as to constitute a hazard or obstruction to the movement of pedestrian or vehicle traffic on a public right of way;
4. a vehicle that has remained on private property without the consent of the owner, or person in control, of that property, for more than forty-eight (48) hours;
5. a vehicle from which has been removed the engine, transmission, or differential or that is otherwise partially dismantled or inoperable and left on public property;
6. a vehicle that is six (6) or more model years old and mechanically inoperable, and left on private property continuously in a location visible from public property for more than thirty (30) days;
7. a vehicle which does not have a currently valid Indiana License plate there-to and a current valid registration with the license plate being visible from public property.

SECTION TWO: The penalty for violation of any article under SECTION ONE of this Ordinance shall be as follows:

1. The owner or person in control of the property if said vehicle is on private property shall be notified by the Marshall to remove within thirty (30) days or said vehicle or parts shall be removed at the owners or person in control expense.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passing.


