

ORDINANCE NO. 92-2

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 90-9 CONCERNING
THE CONNECTION TO AND USE OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS
AND DRAINS AND THE PUBLIC SEWER SYSTEM OF THE
TOWN OF SILVER LAKE, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver Lake, Indiana, did provide by its Ordinance No. 90-9, adopted on October 30, 1990, for the connection to and use of public and private sewers and drains, and for a public sewer system for the Town of Silver Lake; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to establish dates for connecting to the public sewer system; procedures for approved delays in connecting; and penalties for the failure to comply with deadline dates; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Silver Lake, Indiana, now deems it necessary and desirable to amend Ordinance No. 90-9 in certain particulars and to so provide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SILVER LAKE, INDIANA:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 90-9 providing for the connection to and the use of public and private sewers and drains and the public sewer system of the Town of Silver Lake, Indiana, be amended by deleting Section 17 therefrom.

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 90-9 shall be further amended by adding a new Section 17 which shall read as follows:

Section 17. (a) The owner or owners of all houses, buildings or properties as defined in Section 2(h) hereof must, at their expense install suitable toilet facilities therein, and then connect such facilities directly with the proper public sewer in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance no later than July 5, 1992, provided that said public sewer is within three hundred feet (300') of their property line.

(b) Any owner or owners not in compliance with the terms of this Ordinance on July 6, 1992, and not having a valid extension of this deadline date issued by the Town Council of the Town of Silver Lake, Indiana, will be subject to the penalty provisions of this Ordinance.

(c) The Town Council of the Town of Silver Lake, Indiana, shall have the power to grant to any person or persons an extension of time to comply with the terms of this Ordinance. The Town Council shall meet on June 9, 1992 to consider all extensions requested of it by that date.

(d) Any person who violates the provisions of Section 17(a) hereof shall be fined in the amount of Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per day upon being adjudged in violation of this Ordinance. Each day in which a violation occurs shall be deemed a separate offense hereunder.

(e) Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall pay all costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees, which are incurred by the Town of Silver Lake in the enforcement of the provisions of this Ordinance.

(f) Any person found to be violating any provisions of this Ordinance other than section 17(a) shall be served by the Town with written notice stating the nature of the violation and providing a reasonable time limit for the satisfactory correction thereof. the offender shall, within the period of time stated in such notice, permanently cease all violations.

(g) Any person who shall continue any violation beyond the time limit provided for in Section 17(f) shall be guilty of a violation and on conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding two thousand five hundred and no/100 dollars (\$2,500.00) for each violation. Each day in which any violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as provided by law.
